Rationale for DB-ALM

The DB-ALM provides **ready-to-use information** on various aspects of **non-animal methods** in biomedical sciences and toxicology with various levels of detail, both in use for research and regulatory purposes. **Over 5,000 registrations from 82 countries** covering the entire period of online access shows **continued interest** in the service. **Over 3,800 downloads** between July 2016 and June 2017 correspond to **an increase of over 30%** compared to the previous year, **representing the highest total in 11 years of public access.**
